Jeremy moved to Peterborough from Trenton about 5 years ago. He enrolled in the Employment Supports program with Alternatives in January of 2018, on a friend's recommendation.

Jeremy contracted a polio virus in 1999 which resulted in Transverse Myelitis. This affects Jeremy's ability to walk, sit or stand for long periods of time. It also affects his ability to lift heavy objects. Jeremy was determined to improve his life, starting with finding work that he could do and that would inspire him.

Jeremy completed a short-term work placement at Square Plates restaurant on Armour Road. This inspired him to enroll in a 6-week culinary training program at The Mount. The program included 120-hours of unpaid work placement which Jeremy completed at Ashburnham Ale House. Jeremy's acquired skills and his enthusiastic dedication resulted in an offer of full-time employment with **Ashburnham Ale House**, a popular and busy **East City restaurant**. We are very proud of Jeremy's efforts as he faced his challenges, worked hard, accepted the support offered and is now 'over the moon' about his job and his life.

After the work is done Jeremy likes playing darts and doing anything in the great outdoors, especially camping.
