



Program Details

The Alternatives-Employment Supports program is governed by Ontario Disability Supports Program (ODSP). Alternatives-Employment Support specialists support people who qualify for ODSP Employment Supports, who are 16 years of age or older, living with barriers to employment and live in Peterborough City and County.

Alternatives-Employment Supports program is dedicated to our clients and to assisting them to achieve their employment goals.

The employment support specialist will help you with;

- 1. Filling out the ODSP-Employment Supports Application
- 2. Pre-Employment activities such as; skills assessment, employability assessment, emotional intelligence improvement, resume and cover letter writing, job readiness training, interview preparation
- Job Development; searching for available jobs within your skill set and desired job industry. Assist you with applying for jobs online or in person

- 4. Job Acquisition- Finding a job; 13-week job placements with on the-job support or job coaching as required.
- 5. Job Retention-33 months of support to retain position
- If not retained at your placement...we will assist you to find another job. (Conditions apply)
